# KOALA CARNIVAL

Play will be in accordance with the LAWS of the SPORT of BOWLS and the ROYAL NEW SOUTH WALES BOWLING ASSOCIATION BY-LAWYS except as indicated below.

## LOCAL RULES

In the event of inclement weather curtailing play, a decision will be made by the controlling body as to the number of ends that will count.

Two rounds will be played on the day. Each game will come to an end after 19 ends or if slow play warrants it, the bell. One trial end before first game.

NO DEAD ENDS - The end is to continue with the jack placed on a mark 1.5m either side of the line and 2m from the front ditch boundary, on the side that the jack went out of bounds.

SCORING - A points system will be used to determine the winners. Three (3) points will be awarded for a game win (in the event of a drawn game, each team will be awarded one and a half (1 and 1/2) points. One (1) point will be awarded for each end won and half (1/2) point for a tied end. Overall winner, runner-up and third place winner must have won two games on the day. The overall winner will have the greatest number of points over the two games, overall runner-up will have the next greatest number of points over the two games and overall third will have the next greatest number of points over the two games. In the event that teams are even on games and points awarded, count backs will be applied starting with overall margins, then, if still equal, shot margins on the last game. The winners of game one and two will have the highest number of points in that particular game (excluding the overall winner, overall runner-up and overall third). In the event that teams are even on points awarded, count backs will be applied starting with shot margins, then, if still equal, the shot margins on the last end will be the determinant.

No teams will be eligible to win more than one prize.

The umpire's decision is final in relation to play. Any other decision will be made by the controlling body and will be final.
