## NSW State Junior Championships

NSW State Junior Championships were played at Warilla Bowls & Rec Club over 7<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> July. Zone 10 were represented by Mason Lewis, Kyle Breese & Jordan Peisley (All Merrylands) and Sam Hatch-Caccamo (Carlingford). The boys represented Zone 10, their home clubs and themselves with distinction, making the Fours Grand final and being crowned Champions in the Pairs.



## 2014 U-Design Club Challenge



Bowls NSW is pleased to announce U-Design, official uniform supplier to the NSW Keno Blues, as the naming rights sponsor of the 2014 U-Design Club Challenge.

The U-Design Bowls Club Challenge pits sides of seven club based bowlers up against each other in singles, pairs and fours with the side to win two (or more) of the three contests (disciplines) winning the match.

The format has been very well received by competitors, with feedback about the competition being overwhelmingly positive.

Two changes have been made for the 2014 competition. The eligibility for the Men's Silver Division has been changed to players Graded in Grade 3 or below in their previous season, while the number of ends played in the pairs has been changed to 18.

Clubs may enter as many sides as they wish in the six divisions being contested. There are three Men's, two Women's and a Mixed Division. The Silver, Pink and Blue Divisions are restricted to players from lower Pennant grades, ensuring players have the opportunity to play against others of similar abilities.

Women Pink	Restricted to players from Grade 3 Pennants and below

Mixed Gold	Unrestricted for Players Gradings Singles - 1 Male or 1 Female players Pairs - 1 Male and 1 Female player Fours - 2 Male and 2 Female players
Mixed Bronze	Restricted to players from Grade 3 Pennants and below Singles - 1 Male or 1 Female players Pairs - 1 Male and 1 Female player Fours - 2 Male and 2 Female players
	<i>Players Gradings to determine eligibility are from the 2014 season or their previous season if not graded in 2014</i>

Sides are arranged into local sections, playing up to six round robin matches to determine a section winner that will progress to the knockout regional finals, ultimately reaching the final four and progressing to the State Finals.

Sides reaching the State Finals will receive prize money, and sides contesting the State finals who have greater than 150km to travel will receive some travel assistance.

The entry fee for each side is \$84.

The 2014 State Finals series will be held at Warilla Bowling Club on Saturday 5 and Sunday 6 December. Warilla Bowling Club is a magnificent club boasting three sensational tift dwarf greens, an outdoor synthetic greens and an 8 rink indoor green.
