Vale Robert 'Sipper' Robson (30th September 1919 – 16th August 2014) aged 94

Hunters Hill bowlers & members are mourning one of the true gentlemen, legends, icons and champions on the greens, with the sad news that Rob 'Sipper' Robson has passed away early on Saturday 16th August, after a short period in Concord Hospital.

'Sipper' as he was affectionally known as was a foundation bowling member at Brush Park BC back in 1960. Rob won the 1960 Club's first Major Singles Championship and backed up again in 1961 followed by winning the Pairs in 1962 and the Club Triples in 1963. He was invited to bowl at Hunters Hill Club after that period and has been an icon ever since at HHC.

His bowling achievements at HHC include: Fours titles in 1979, 1994, 1997, 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004 and 2009. K&L Handicap Pairs in 1984, 2003 and 2013, Triples 2002 a total of 17 titles at both Brush Park & HHC, a great achievement & I'm sure his family are very proud of what he has won on the greens. Sipper was awarded Life Membership at Hunters Hill in 2009 and a chairperson of the famous Pelican Club at HHC.

He became our first 94 year old champion with his last win in 2013. Ten years earlier Sipper was the skipper and the then lead beginner Charles Phillips to win the 2003 K & L Handicap Pairs Final and repeated that victory again in 2013 winning 21/9.

On behalf of all the bowlers and members that have played with or against Sipper on the many greens in Sydney, no greater experience in life than to have known this truly gentlemen. We pass on our condolences to the family and may he rest in peace, you will never be forgotten.
