No 1 Pennants

The Board of Bowls NSW has resolved that Grade 1 Pennants across NSW will be revamped from next year, with the implementation of a new competition format in 2015 which will combine 16 sides from each of the Sydney Zones (9, 10, 11, 12 and 13) across two geographically-based sections. This restructure is aimed at establishing a sustainable and meaningful competition for all players and Clubs who aspire to compete at the highest level possible.

At the completion of a 7 sectional rounds of the competition, a 3-week finals series will be played for the chance for one of the sides to be crowned the Metropolitan Champion. The 5 Metro Zones will then each host a Final between their top 2 sides, with each Zone winner qualifying to compete in the State Pennant Finals as per previous years. It is proposed that the combined-Zone format will then be expanded Statewide in 2016 to provide the opportunity for Clubs from any Zones across NSW to participate under the revised Grade 1 Pennant structure.

It is anticipated that the new 2016 structure will see the State divided into 'Conferences', with sides competing against each other within those conferences, instead of Zone boundaries, to produce a winner to qualify for the State Finals. The Conferences (and the various sections within them (if required) would be established on the basis of geographic regions to create viable competition numbers and minimal travel for participating sides.

Five regional conferences have been proposed:

Western NSW
 Northern NSW
 Newcastle/Hunter
 South Coast
 Greater Sydney Metropolitan Additional details including the proposed makeup and format of competition and conference structures from 2016 will be given further consideration in the coming months in consultation with Zone Committees.

Grade 1 Pennant Competition

Proposed – Combine the 5 Metropolitan Zones for Grade 1

- SMC Controlling Body (Competition draw and collation of results etc)
- Sectional Play of the State Grade 1 Pennant Competition
- All aspects of State COP will apply.
- Grade 1 Promotion and Relegation as per COP Reviewed Yearly.
- Inclusive of all 5 Metropolitan Zones (16 Sides from Zones 9,10, 11, 12 and 13)
- 16 Sides Split into 2 Sections comprising 8 Sides (Geographical draw).
- 3 Sides from Each Zone plus highest Metro Gr2 Side. (16 Sides)
- SMC reserves the right to invite-select sides with Zone consultation.
- 7 Round Competition plus 3 Week Final Series
- Each of the 5 Metropolitan Zones has a Grade 1 FINAL (The Highest two sides from each Zone after Sectional Rounds to play a Final).
- Each Zone Final played in their Zone
- Grade 1 Zone Winners to play at Grade 1 State Finals.
- A Metropolitan Champion is decided over a 3 week Final Series.
- Grade 1 Competition to be reviewed yearly.

GRADE 1 SYDNEY METROPOLITAN PENNANT COMPETITION MODEL

Composition of Sides in 2 Sections

(3 Sides from each Zone plus (16th Side – Highest Grade 2 Metro Side)

Inclusion of a Grade 2 Side will create 4 sides from a Zone. The 4 sides will split with 2 sides in each Section.

Based on results from 2014 and as an **example**, the Sections would be made up of the following clubs with the top 3 clubs from each Zone (according to 2014 results) + Cabramatta would have a 2nd side in due to them winning Grade 2 State Pennants in 2014. Dependant on who was the best performed side in Grade 2 (out of Zones 9, 10, 11, 12 & 13) would determine how the Sections were divided to try to alleviate the longest travel. Promotion & relegation would also be a part of the selection process each year.

Each side in each Section would play against each other once – 1 section x 8 Sides x 7 Competition rounds. Once the 7 rounds are completed, the top 2 sides from each Zone would then play off to decide the Club to represent their Zone at the State Zone Pennant Play-Offs. There would also be a 3 week playoff to decide the champion Metropolitan Club – the format to be confirmed.

Editors Comment - Mark Waters

This is a massive step for Bowls NSW to implement, especially with such a short lead in time, and there obviously will be supporters and detractors. The sport of bowls has been around for a long time, and in reality, very little has changed over the years to get the best players playing against each other on a regular basis. Yes Premier League has come and gone, replaced by the Champions League but the Grade 1 competition has struggled in many zones for many years due to the number of clubs that simply do not have the talent to match the top clubs - whether this has simply been the lack of numbers within a club, players moving for financial inducements or players moving just to get the chance to better their game by competing regularly against stronger players within a club. With the restriction of 3 clubs per Zone in Grade 1, there will now be a number of clubs that their Grade 2's will be strengthened, with this in turn filtering down through the grades to eventually(hopefully) even up the competition. It is up to these clubs to ensure that they foster growth within their clubs, as not all players aim for the No 1 Grades and are happy to play their Pennants knowing that they are a reasonable chance of competing against players of a similar standard both within their zone and state. Only time will tell how this change will result, but there has to be some form of change – and it needs to be sooner or later.

Zone 10 Executive

With the year-end fast approaching, the Zone Executive is asking that all Zone 10 members start giving some thought to nominating for the 2015 Zone 10 Committees (Match & Game, Selectors, Coaching & Umpires). These are very important positions to ensure the continuing smooth running of the Zone and new blood, fresh ideas and constructive input are very welcome and certainly encouraged. Don't be that person that sits at your local club around the Table of Knowledge (or No Idea) and complains about the direction taken within our and your Zone – be proactive and become a part of one of the strongest Zones within NSW.

GUINNESS WORLD RECORD ATTEMPT

News from HHC is that like many other clubs around Australia HHC is supporting Chris Thomas in his attempt on Guinness World Record for the most bowling clubs he can play at in 12 months. I played Chris Thomas earlier this week in his bid to break the Guinness World record for the most bowls club played in a year over 10 ends.

After the game I asked him how some Q's on how supports his challenge. Basically he has a caravan and staying at North Ryde Caravan Park while in Sydney and then moves around to other camping areas pending the clubs he plays at. He plays on the average 2 to 3 games a day mostly 7 days a week. He gets support from Men's Shed, Cancer Council Australia

His challenge started in July this year and will finish in July 2015. Currently he has played in 300 plus clubs and another bowler is also trying the same idea only that he finishes in January 2015 & he has played 500 plus clubs to date.

Chris is looking to the support of each of the bowling clubs he plays at for financial support via donations and the purchase of Cancer Council polo shirts at \$49.

Maybe this is a chance for all the clubs in Zone 10 to support Chris in his attempt. When I spoke after our game he indicated the many Zone 10 clubs he was playing in this week.

Australian Premier League

















The Australian Premier League is set to be staged again from November 18 to 21, under lights at Brisbane's premier bowls facility, Club Pine Rivers - with free admission for spectators to experience the adrenaline-fueled format.

Matches begin at 1pm AEST daily, with the competition broadcast live on Fox Sports and SKY NZ from 5pm-10.00pm during the four days of competition, providing unprecedented exposure for the sport of bowls.

APL snapshot

- Each team shall comprise of 3 players plus a non-playing coach
- Two players from each Team shall be nominated to compete in the game (lead/skip).
 - The third player will be the substitute for that team.
- Playing positions / order between the 3 players may be altered at any time, provided that the order must not be altered once an end has commenced.

Competition Format

- The APL will be played as a sectional based competition in the preliminary rounds and convert to a "knock out" format for all finals play
 - The event will be played in "sets play" format

Game Format – Pairs

- There will be three (3) bowls per player for each end
- Each game will be played over two sets with each set consisting of 5 ends
