Turn Around Triples - Conditions of Play

- 1. The World Bowls Laws of the Sport of Bowls in Australian shall apply except as modified hereunder.
- 2. The Controlling Body is the **Men's Bowling Club Match Committee** which reserves the right to alter the advertised format in any way it considers necessary to bring the Carnival to a satisfactory conclusion. In particular if rain stops or delays play the **Match Committee** reserves the right to determine on which end the game(s) shall be deemed to be completed.
- 3. There will be three (3) games of three (3) bowl triples, each game comprising twelve (12) ends. There will be an end roll-up before each game.
- 4. Each team member must play one game as <u>Lead</u>, one game as <u>Second</u> and one game as <u>Skip</u>. The order in which this is played is at the team's discretion.
- 5. There will be no dead ends. If the jack goes out of bounds it must be re-spotted on the centre line either on or as near as possible to (a) the two metre mark or (b) the end of the centre line chalk mark, at the discretion of the non- offending team.
- 6. A points system will be used to determine the winners. Three (3) points will be awarded for a game win. In the event of a drawn game teams will each be awarded $1\frac{1}{2}$ points. One (1) point will be awarded for each end won and half ($\frac{1}{2}$) a point for a tied end. (A drawn game is a "half win".)
- 7. The overall prize winner and overall runners-up must have the <u>most game wins and highest number</u> <u>of points awarded over the three (3) games</u>. In the event that teams are even on games and points awarded, count backs will be applied starting with overall shot margins, then, if still equal, shot margins on the last game.
- 8. The winners of games one, two and three will be the team with the highest number of points awarded in that particular game (excluding the overall winner and runners-up). In the event teams are even on points awarded, count backs will be applied starting with shot margins then, if still equal, the highest number of "shots for" will be the determinant.
- 9. No team can win more that one prize.
