CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

2015 MAJOR CLUB FOURS (Graded 17) CHAMPIONSHIP

Preliminaries:

Conditions of Entry in this competition will be subject to acceptance of the match schedule, rules and conditions of play as set out below. Player's who place their name on the Nomination Form below, are deemed to have read and agreed to the Conditions as set out.

Closing Date:

Nominations for this event close on **Saturday 26th September 2015 at 5pm**, with the draw being made immediately thereafter.

Eligibility:

In order to be eligible to play in any club championship, a player must be a financial member of West Pennant Hills Men's Bowling Section and be registered with the Royal New South Wales Bowling Association at the time of nomination for the event and during the playing of the event.

In addition, participants must not have played in an association event for any other club during the calendar year without written consent from RNSWBA Match Committee. (For association events players' eligibility rule shall be as per State Conditions of play 2.6).

Player's points must add up to a minimum of 17 points with no more than 2 persons of any grade being part of the team. eg 2xGr 4, 1xGr 5 and 1xGr6 or 1xGr4, 2xGr5,and 1xGr6 or 2xGr5, 2xGr6.

Note Ungraded players can be included in teams and will be counted as Grade 6 points

Matches:

All matches shall be 2 bowls and 21 ends with 2 Trial Ends

All matches will be played on Saturdays. The Match Committee reserves the right to make amendments to this schedule in the event of less than eight (8) entries being received. The Match committee also reserves the right to make any other changes it sees fit in order to bring the competition to a satisfactory conclusion:-.

Conditions of Play:

Shall be as per the WPH Men's Bowling Club Conditions of Play. Where not covered by WPH COP then the Zone 10/State Conditions of Play will be used as a guide.

All matches are to be played "on or before the schedule date (Rule 5.7.1 WPH COP)" as shown above. Any request for a change of date must be in writing. The Match Committee will consider the request. Such approval will only be granted under WPH COP - Rules 5.7and Rule 8.

The play or **forfeit** rule will apply at all times with the following exceptions:

- a player playing or officiating in a State or Zone game or representing the club
- long weekend or public holiday.

The Club's dress code calls for anyone participating in any Club championship, Pennant team or in any outside competition where the participants have entered under the WPH banner, **must** wear the Club's official Red, White and Blue shirt. **Anyone who arrives to play in the incorrect uniform will not be permitted to take their place in the competition**.

All Bowls in a Team/singles game will have all bowls with either all "WPH Stickers On" or all bowls with "No Stickers On", failure to abide by this rule may mean disqualification
